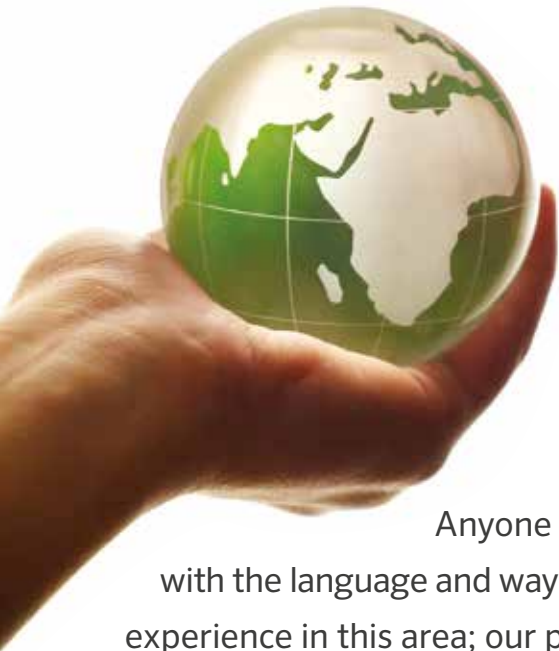

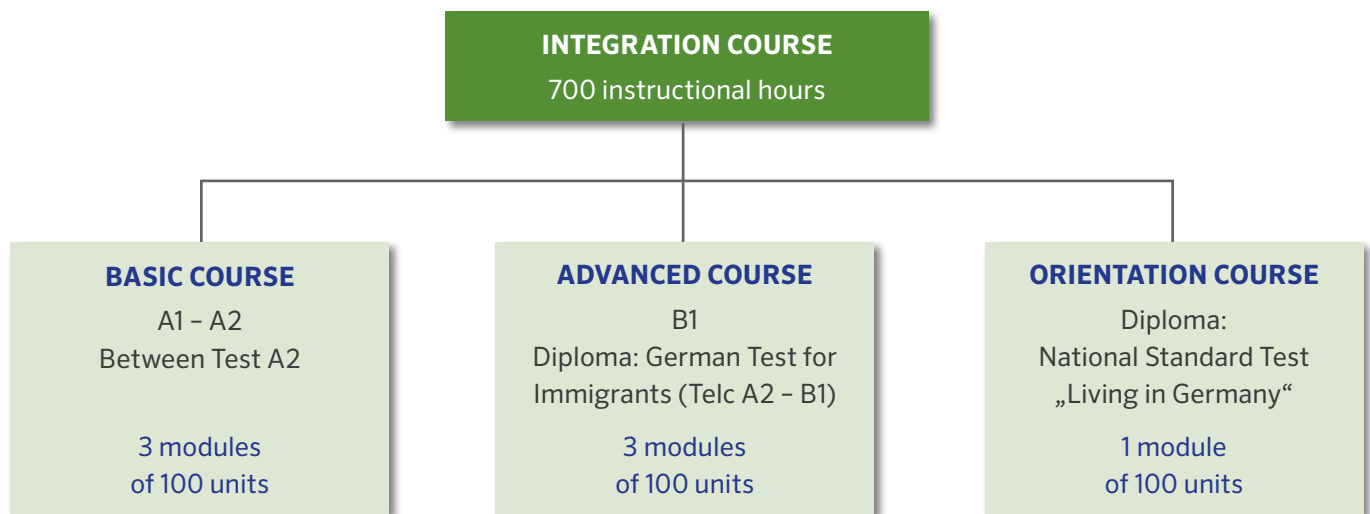

BERLITZ LEVELS AND THE CEF (COMMON EUROPEAN FRAMEWORK)

The fostering of multilingualism as well as the description of learning goals and language levels are basic requirements of the Council of Europe's language policy. The Council of Europe developed recommendations on this subject, which were then presented precisely and in detail in the "Common European Framework of Reference for Languages: Learning, Teaching, Assessment". The six levels of the Common European Framework of Reference make language skills more transparent and comparable. The correlation of the Common European Framework to the Berlitz Levels is as follows:

Berlitz Level 1 / CEF A 1

Your knowledge of the language is sufficient to communicate with elementary questions and answers in simple everyday situations.

Berlitz Level 2 / CEF A 2.1

You have a basic knowledge of the language in social and business situations and can maintain a conversation in at least one tense.

Berlitz Level 3 / CEF A 2.2

You can follow the general meaning of a conversation on familiar topics. You can start, maintain and end a conversation covering a range of topics.

Berlitz Level 4 / CEF A 2.3

You can comprehend information of familiar topics in an appropriate context, and can conduct a sustained conversation with others on a range of general subjects.

Berlitz Level 5 / CEF B 1.1

You conduct conversations and narrate or describe coherently. You can ask and answer questions in the workplace. You understand all basic and complicated sentence structures.

Berlitz Level 6 / CEF B 1.2

This upper intermediate level enables you to communicate comfortably in many professional and private situations using a variety of formulations.

Berlitz Level 7 / CEF B 1.3

You can express opinions and defend your ideas in a discussion. You are able to deal with demanding professional situations, and can use the language in complex situations.

Berlitz Level 8 / CEF B 2.1

You can communicate efficiently and correctly in demanding situations and tasks, and can participate comfortably in social and professional conversations. You can express nuances of meaning on demanding subjects.

Berlitz Level 9 / CEF B 2.2

You can communicate on many familiar and new topics. Your descriptions are detailed and you use idioms correctly to lend discussions on complex subjects a certain style.

Berlitz Level 10 / CEF C 1 / C 2

You have reached an exceptional level of proficiency, close to the level of a native speaker. You understand the language on a very high analytical and critical level.
